Description

The purpose of this Request for Bids (RFB) is to solicit bids from qualified providers to provide the goods and/or services described further in this RFB to the Lead Agency and any Participating Agencies. The Lead Agency intends to award a contract(s) beginning and ending on the dates listed in the solicitation, and the Lead Agency may extend the contract(s) for up to the number of annual extensions identified in the solicitation at the sole discretion of the Lead Agency. The annual operating period would be April 1st to October 31st. The RFB will contain 10 tasks. The first 5 will be for Lewis and Clark and the remaining 5 will be for Wilson Island. Contractors may choose to bid on 1 location or both. Each location will be awarded separately.
